20th Nov Understanding Autism - repeat of 16th Oct training

#### 9<sup>th</sup> Jan Autism: Creating Structured Environments

Looking at how to create a supportive environment in the classroom: setting up clear physical structures, daily schedules, work systems and visual instructions.

28<sup>th</sup> Feb Autism: Supporting Communication and Social Interaction Modelling interventions that can support social interactions: Lego, TALKABOUT, Playground Strategies. Looking at Social Stories and Comic Strips.


### 26th Mar Autism: Understanding Behaviour and Sensory Issues

Analysing behaviour, looking at underlying factors linked to an understanding of autism including sensory processing issues. Using the STAR [setting, trigger, action, result] approach to examine and respond to behaviour.

#### 25th April Autism and Anxiety

Looking at reasons for high levels of anxiety experienced by people with autism. Looking at a range of interventions to help reduce anxiety.
