Brief course description:

Talk Boost KS1 is a targeted intervention for 4-7 year old children with language that is delayed, including children in Reception classes. The programme is delivered in primary schools by classroom teachers and teaching assistants and provides a structured programme that boost children's progress in language and communication by an average of 9-18 months after a ten week interventions.

Learners' outcomes:

- Have gained an overview of typical development of SLC
- Know how to use a tracker to identify appropriate children who need support
- Be confident in understanding how the intervention works
- Have an understanding of the logistical issues involved in setting up Talk Boost Groups.
