TA(s) delivering intervention, class teacher of relevant year group(s) and SENCO must attend as a team from each school. If the SENCO has attended another Talk Boost programme they don't need to attend this one.

Area of SEND: SLCN

Brief course description:

Talk Boost KS2 is a 10 week intervention programme supporting children's language and communication skills, running for about 30-40 minutes 3 times a week.

It is one of the only specific interventions that focus on language disadvantage rather than impairments or difficulties. KS2 is aimed at year 3, 4 and 5.

Your school will need to send TA and teacher pairs from the targeted year group/s. In addition the SENCO must also attend the training if they haven't already attended another Talk Boost training.
