Brief course description:

Early Talk Boost is a 10 week intervention programme supporting children's language and communication skills, running for about 30-40 minutes 3 times a week.

It is one of the only specific interventions that focus on language disadvantage rather than impairments or difficulties. Early Talk Boost is aimed at nursery and reception.

Your school will need to send the early years lead and the early year's practitioner who will be running the training.

The course is free but you will need to order materials from ICAN with a minimum cost of about £500.
