Brief course description:

Talk Boost KS1 is a targeted intervention for 4-7 year old children with language that is delayed, including children in Reception classes. The programme is delivered in primary schools by classroom teachers and teaching assistants and provides a structured programme that boost children's progress in language and communication by an average of 9-18 months after a ten week interventions. The intervention materials for the programme cost £500 (which works out at about 50p per child over the year) and need to be ordered directly from the ican at www.icancharity.org.uk
