SEN local area reviews

- •joint inspection framework
- •how effectively the local area meets its responsibilities
- •local area includes the local authority and health service, early years settings, schools, further education providers and specialist services

Key questions

- •identify
- Assess and meet the needs
- •improve outcomes for children and young people who have special educational needs and/or disabilities

During the inspection

- consist of three inspectors and will normally last five days
- interview key officers
- meetings with children and young people as well as parent and carer groups
- •visit other providers, such as nurseries, schools, colleges and specialist services
- aware of concerns of a safeguarding or child protection nature, they will make additional enquiries

Following the inspection

- ■report will be in the form of a letter
- •judgements will be given within the narrative of the report

What is the Local Authority and Health Service doing in response to this new inspection framework?

- Local Authority has set up a steering group
- •self-evaluation will identify particular strengths across provision, areas of best practice, gaps in the local offer and areas for further improvement

How can schools contribute?

- ■all providers and services should be available to be involved in the self-evaluation process
- providers and services had conducted their own selfevaluation
