
ORANGE CLASS WEEKLY PLAN Week 1

7 O'clock, time to get up.


This week we will be focused on getting dressed. All of our activities will be connected with clothes, laces, bottoms. Everything related with getting dressed.

We will use our sensory bag for them to practise with the different pockets with laces , ropes, bottoms






ORANGE CLASS WEEKLY PLAN


What's the time Mr Wolf?

This week we will be focused on brushing teeth. We can keep using the schedule that you received previously for helping them to brush their teeth.






We will prepare a tray with tooth paste and toothbrush and we will let them explore and play as a way to approach to the action of brushing teeth.



Activity 2

This activity will be very basic but very useful for fine motors skills and pencil control. We can paint the teeth with a whiteboard pen or any pen no permanent and our children they will clean them pretending that they are brushing the teeth.



We will make a mouth with marshmallows teeth. All the products that we use are suitable for all of our students. We will follow the schedule and we will use the symbols for requesting. We will make a mix of icing sugar and water as edible glue. Then we will deep the marshmallow into the mix and we will stick them into de cardboard.
