Reading



All children have the absolute right to be taught to read, whatever it takes, and for however long. One of the most exciting things we do in College Park school is to get every child an opportunity to read at their individual level.

There are specific reading programs that are implemented and sequenced throughout the school including using symbols and PIXON boards for developing reading skills, phonics program, guided reading and developing functional reading skills through reading environmental signs.

We encourage reading for pleasure through the class daily reading sessions. To promote the love for reading, we have developed our school library in the downstairs café, where pupils can engage in a quiet reading time with their teachers. We have also established a successful link with the local library (Porchester Children's Library) where the children are encouraged to choose a book and share it with their teacher.
