Outline

To consider how and why autistic CYP may be affected by transitions.

To think about transitions at different stages e.g. between nursery / reception; primary / secondary; home / school; between lessons

To be able to think about strategies which can be used to support transition in a range of different settings and situations

Description

During the session, you will get the opportunity to explore why it can be difficult for autistic pupils to transition and to share examples.

You will be able to share strategies and consider how these could be implemented in your setting. Think about the preparation which needs to go into transition in order to support the needs of an autistic CYP.

You will have some approaches to:

- identifying challenging times when children need to transition
- have a range of resources and ideas which you can adapt to suit your setting
- to support children during those challenging times
