### **Literacy/ communication:**

- We will explore the sensory story 'We are going on a bear hunt' through sensory play
- We will explore the sensory story 'Wake Up on Bumble Farm'
- We will explore the sensory story of 'The Scarecrow's Wedding'
- We will develop our understanding of phonics activities on sound discrimination including animal sounds
- We will act out some stories and songs e.g Dingle Dangle Scarecrow
- We will practice our gross and fine motor skills to support our mark making
- We will develop our attention and communication skills through many and varied activities including Intensive Interaction and Attention Autism activities.
- We will develop our functional communication skills through e.g through PECs and symbols.

### **Numeracy:**

- We will take turns on the interactive board for Topmarks activities
- We will practice counting through play with animals
- We will familiarise ourselves with numbers symbols
- We will have counting opportunities during messy play
- We will have counting opportunities during fine motor skills activities
- We will explore group and sizes of groups by playing games with hiding animals
- We will use number names and language in play
- We will explore shape space and measure through messy play with pourina and resources

### **Understanding the world:**

- We will begin to learn to look after growing plants e.g cress & watering the garden
- We will learn vegetables; exploring music and tasting and messy play
- We will enhance our play skills through small world play
- We will learn songs animal, farming and vegetable songs
- We will learn about jobs that need to be done on a farm
- We will explore making shadows of farm animals with torches and animals
