*Music Makes Me is presented by the **Tri-borough Music Hub**, in co-production with the **Royal Albert Hall**, and in partnership with the **Royal College of Music**.*

*Over one thousand pupils will perform **Music Makes Me**, a new work by **Emily Stratford** and **Gabriel Krchnavek** which celebrates the importance of music as a universal communicator and as a tool to give young people a voice.*

*Following in the footsteps of award-winning TBMH productions, **Seven Seeds** and **Convo**, **Music Makes Me** is a new original large-scale work. This multi-school music education and performance programme will bring together students of Hammersmith & Fulham, Kensington & Chelsea, and Westminster.*

*The original songs have been co-designed by young people with special educational needs, alongside specialist musicians. The narrative of the work presents a day in the life of a neuro-divergent young person and shows how music helps her emotionally regulate, socially interact, and build her independence for adulthood. **Music Makes Me** truly shows how music is for all.*
