

Safeguarding

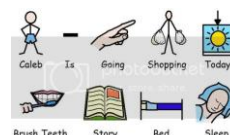
Safeguarding is extremely important to us at College Park School.
