Class information

What are we doing this term?

This term, Beaver class will be exploring the exciting theme of Plants and Gardens, with a strong focus on sensory learning, communication, and developing independence. Pupils will engage in hands-on activities such as planting seeds, exploring natural materials like soil and leaves, and taking part in our sensory story Jack and the Beanstalk. Across the curriculum, we will be building key skills in communication, early maths, and life skills through practical, engaging experiences linked to nature and seasonal change. There will also be a continued emphasis on developing independence in areas such as dressing for outdoor learning and exploring a wider range of foods.

As part of our learning, we are planning community walks to Hallfield and Diana Memorial Playground, where pupils will explore their local environment, practise safety skills, and observe seasonal changes in real life. We will also be making use of outdoor spaces for gardening and sensory play, giving pupils meaningful opportunities to connect their classroom learning with the world around them.

We hope to attend a joint class trip with Penguin class to Hallfield in May. As well as a trip to the Diana Memorial Playground in the month of June.
