### What are we doing this term?

This term, our topic is “Plants and Gardens”. Pupils will explore plants and the natural environment through sensory activities, learning how things grow and change, and developing their understanding of the world around them.

In English, we will be focusing on the sensory story *The Enormous Turnip*, using symbols, objects and Makaton to support communication, attention and early reading skills. Pupils will continue to develop their use of AAC to request, comment and interact throughout the day.

In Maths and across the curriculum, pupils will develop early number, communication and independence skills through practical, real-life learning opportunities within school, such as routines, play and structured activities.

We are also planning a trip to Hallfield playground, where pupils will practise communication, safety and social skills in the community. We are looking forward to a fun and engaging term!
