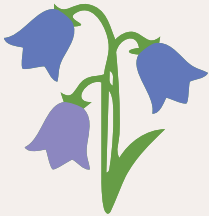

What are we doing this term?

This summer term, Bluebell Class will be enjoying a range of fun, sensory activities to support communication, independence and early learning. We'll be exploring stories such as The Very Hungry Caterpillar and Jack and the Beanstalk, while building early reading skills through phonics and symbol communication. Our learning will focus on plants and the natural world, with pupils planting seeds, exploring materials like soil and water, and watching how things grow. Through hands on activities, we'll be practising key Maths skills like counting, sorting and comparing, as well as developing attention, communication and motor skills. We'll also be working on important life skills through role play and visits to the local park, helping pupils build confidence and learn more about the world around them.
