What are we doing this term?

Our Topic this term is Plants and Gardens. Daffodil Class will investigate new plants from different countries, explore where they come from and this is linked to Oliver's Vegetables.

In Science we will develop our understanding of the cycle of a plant, understanding the sequence of growth and investigate different types of plants and gardens, as well as habitats, with a focus on gardens as environments for insects and other living things.

In our sensory story we are following the story of Jack and the Beanstalk. Through this story the learners will explore props, they will be encouraged to communicate using their communication books. Answering who, what and where questions to develop our sentence structures and using adjectives within the story of Jack and the Beanstalk.
