## Class information

### What are we doing this term?

This term, students will explore Plants and Gardens across the curriculum. In English, they will describe and compare plants, practise sequencing and simple recounts, and study James and the Giant Peach. Maths will focus on time, counting patterns, ordering numbers, money, and timetables. Science will cover healthy eating and plant growth, while PSHE and Life Skills will develop hygiene, relationships, boundaries, and independence. Students will also learn about ecosystems, geography, and early British history to link learning to the wider world.



## Class Trips

To enrich their learning, students will take part in trips to parks and gardens across London, bringing their topic to life through real-world experiences. We will also continue our weekly routines, with visits to the local library every Monday and trips to Tesco every Tuesday and Thursday to support community and life skills development.
