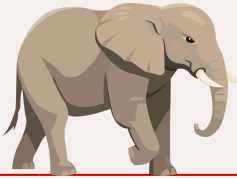

## Class information

### What are we doing this term?

Elephant Class will explore plants, gardens, and the environment through hands-on, sensory activities tailored to each pupil. In English, pupils will use Mrs Rumphius and Jack and the Beanstalk to build functional communication, sequencing, and descriptive language. Maths will develop early number skills, time, measuring, and grouping through practical gardening activities. Science will focus on planting, plant needs, and growth through weekly experiments and practical tasks. PSHE and Life Skills will build responsibility, social skills, emotional awareness, and safety through gardening routines and outdoor learning. In RE, pupils will learn about summer celebrations from different religions and cultures.
