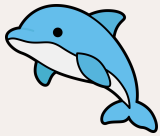

What are we doing this term?

Dolphin Class will be exploring the topic of Plants and Gardens this term through practical and engaging learning across all subjects. Pupils will develop communication through *The Jungle Book*, build early maths skills such as sequencing and time, and explore how humans and plants grow in Science. In PSHE, we will focus on independence, turn-taking, safety, and real-life routines. Learning will be supported through structured, multi-sensory activities and outdoor opportunities, including short local walks to practise community and life skills.

In addition, pupils will take part in regular short local walks throughout the term (e.g. visits to nearby parks and shops) to support the development of real-life skills such as community awareness, waiting, and following instructions.
